



ANZSCDB Awards at ComBio in Brisbane 3-7 October 2016

A. ANZSCDB Research and Presentation Awards

1. The Toshiya Yamada Early Career Award - value \$500

Best oral presentation in the fields of Cell or Developmental Biology by a junior postdoc (within 5 years of completing PhD)

2. The David Walsh Student Prize - value \$350

Best oral presentation in the fields of Cell or Developmental Biology by a student

3. The Keith Dixon Prize in Developmental Biology - value \$350

Best poster presentation in the field of Developmental Biology by a student

4. The Cell Biology Student Poster Prize – value \$350

Best poster presentation in the field of Cell Biology by a student

All Postdoc and Student members who submit abstracts as presenting author at ComBio are eligible for these awards. All presenting authors are encouraged to indicate on their abstract submission form that they would be prepared to give an ORAL presentation, although this is not obligatory for award eligibility.

These awards are announced and presented at the closing ceremony of the ComBio meeting.

B. ComBio Student Travel Awards

The ANZSCDB will consider applications by its student members to contribute to their registration for the ComBio2016 conference, subject to certain eligibility requirements (see below). The total number of bursaries awarded will be determined by the availability of funding.

Eligibility requirements:

1. The applicant must be enrolled in a postgraduate degree in the year their application is made.
2. The applicant and his/her supervisor must be ANZSCDB members at the time the application is made. (There are no time restrictions on membership – applicants may join immediately prior to registration.)
3. The applicant must pay a registration fee and submit an online abstract for presentation at the ComBio2016 meeting by the EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION and abstract submission deadline, and attach a copy of their abstract to their application.
4. The applicant must tick the box stating that they are ANZSCDB members when registering for ComBio2016.
5. A maximum of two student registration bursaries will be provided per supervisor.
6. Preference will be given to those students in the final year of their PhD (or equivalent postgraduate degree program) and those travelling interstate or internationally to attend the ComBio2016 conference.
